



Checkerboard.

56" x 56".

Fabric requirements.

1.25 yard red fabric.

1.5 yards of yellow fabric, including the binding.

1.25 yards black fabric.

1/4 yards patterned fabric.

Batting 60" x 60".

Backing 60" x 60".

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From the red fabric cut :-

4 squares 14.5" x 14.5",
36.8 cm x 36.8 cm.

4 squares 7.5" x 7.5",
19.05 cm x 19.05 cm.

From the yellow fabric cut :-

2 squares 14.5" x 14.5",
36.8 cm x 36.8 cm.

10 squares 7.5" x 7.5",
19.05 cm x 19.05 cm.



From the black fabric cut :-

2 squares 14.5" x 14.5".

10 squares 7.5" x 7.5".

From the patterned fabric cut :-

8 squares 7.5" x 7.5".

From the red fabric cut :-

4 squares 14.5" x 14.5".

4 squares 7.5" x 7.5".

From the yellow fabric cut :-

2 squares 14.5" x 14.5".

10 squares 7.5" x 7.5".

For the binding cut :-

6 strips 2.5" x 44".

From the black fabric cut :-

2 squares 14.5" x 14.5".

10 squares 7.5" x 7.5".

From the patterned fabric cut :-

8 squares 7.5" x 7.5".

All seam allowances are 1/4" , 6 mm. Instructions.

1. Sew one of the small yellow squares to a patterned square, press the seam under the yellow fabric to make A, figure 1, make four A units.

2. Sew one the small black squares to one of the patterned squares to make B, figure 2, press the seam under the black fabric, make four B units.

3. Use the small squares to make the first and forth row of the centre panel :-

To the right of a red square add a black square press the seam under the black square.

To the right of this add a yellow square again press the seam under the black square.

Finally add another red square pressing the seam under the red square. This completes unit C. **Figure 3.**

Make two of these.

4. To make the second and third row :-

Sew a yellow square to the right of a black square press the seam under the black square.

Add another black square to this again press the seam under the black square.

Add another yellow square again press the seam under the black square. This completes unit D. **Figure 4.**

Make two of these.

5. To join the rows together :-

Take one of the C units and a D unit and sew them together. Press the seams open.

Take the second D unit and turn it 180° and add this to the two rows already together. Again press the seams open.

Take the second C unit and turn it 180° and add this to the three rows already together. Again press the seams open. **Figure 5.**

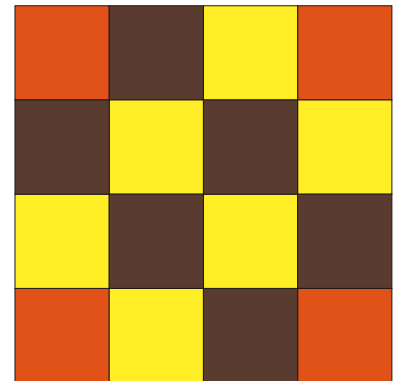
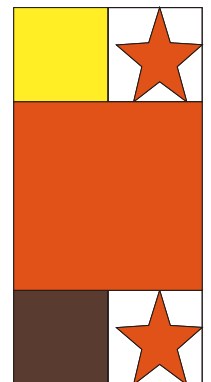

6. To add the sides to the centre panel, first unit E :-

Take an A unit and sew it to the top of one of the large red squares with the yellow square on the left, press the seam under the red fabric.

To the bottom of the red square add a B unit with the black square on the left, press the seam under the red square. Make two of these. **Figure 6.**

7. To the left of the centre panel add unit E. Press the seam open

Take the second unit E turn it 180° and sew it to the right of the centre panel. Press the seam open. Figure 7.

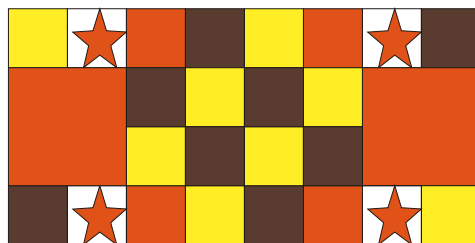


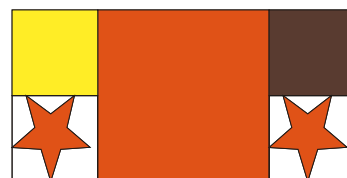

8. To make unit F :-

Take an A unit and sew it to the left side of a large red square with the yellow square at the top. Press the seam under the red square.

Take a B unit and sew it to the right of the red square with the black square on the top. Press the seam under the red square. Figure 8.

Make two of these.

9. To the left side of one of the F units add a large black square, press the seam under the black fabric.

To the right of the F unit add a large yellow square, press the seam under the yellow fabric. Figure 9. This will make unit G make two of these.

10. To the top of one of the G units and sew it to the top of the central panel, figure 10, press the seams open.

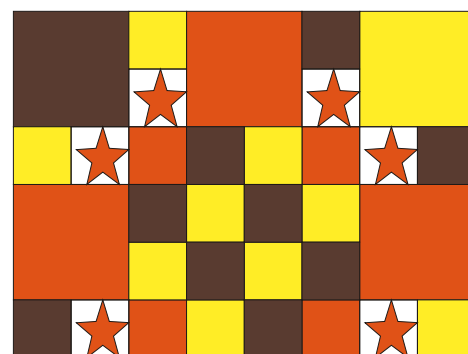

11. Take the other G unit turn it 180° and sew it to the bottom of the central panel figure 11, press the seam open.

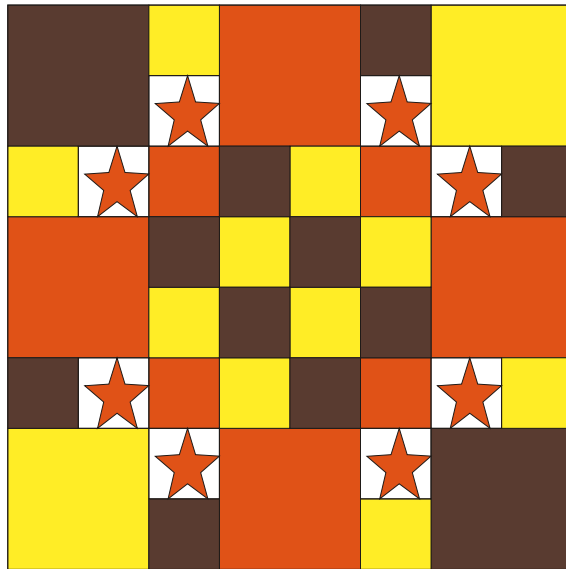
