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Fusible Applique.

Cut out a piece of fusible webbing large enough for all the templates that require the same colour fabric, iron it on to the fabric, as directed by the instructions on the packaging of the fusible webbing, normally the piece of fabric and webbing are the same size .

To draw round the templates place the template on the paper on the back of the webbing you have just ironed on to fabric with the top facing down, draw round all the template as many as you need, figure 1, then cut out the shapes cut along the pencil line, figure 2.

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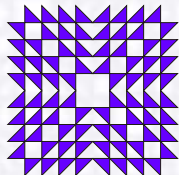
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Before ironing this on to the wall hanging / quilt position the cut
out piece of fabric to make sure it is the correct size, then peel off the
backing paper and iron in place, figure 3.

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Then position under the foot of the sewing machine with the machine stitch set to a small zig zag, (see sewing machine instructions to do this) secure the thread and zig zag round the piece to keep the piece in place, figure 4.

If you have two pieces that meet together make sure the stitch is wide enough to cover the sides of both pieces. Secure the thread when you have gone all the way round. Figure 5.

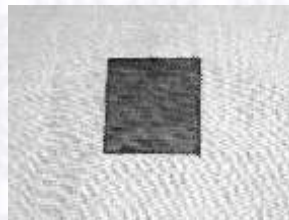
