



Log Cabin Block.

The Log Cabin block can give you many different designs from the one block, this page shows you how to make the Log Cabin block . There are variations of the Log Cabin block this is just one of them. The information below is an example how to make the Log Cabin block, patterns may use different size blocks and different size logs.

All seams are 1/4" inch, fabric colours are just an example.

Cut.

1. Blue fabric 1.5" x 1.5".
2. Pale yellow fabric 1.5" x 1.5".
3. Pale yellow fabric 1.5" x 2.5".
4. Blue fabric 1.5" x 2.5".
5. Blue fabric 1.5" x 3.5".
6. Bright yellow fabric 1.5" x 3.5".
7. Bright yellow fabric 1.5" x 4.5".
8. Blue fabric 1.5" x 4.5".
9. Blue fabric 1.5" x 5.5".
10. Pale yellow fabric 1.5" x 5.5".
11. Pale yellow fabric 1.5" x 6.5".
12. Blue fabric 1.5" x 6.5".
13. Blue fabric 1.5" x 7.5".
14. Bright yellow fabric 1.5" x 7.5".
15. Bright yellow fabric 1.5" x 8.5".

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1. Take pieces number 1 and 2 sew them together. Figure 1, press the seam under the darker square.

2. Add piece number 3 to the left side of the two squares, figure 2, start pressing the seam under each new log that is added.

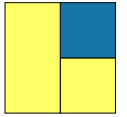

3. Add piece number 4 top the top as figure 3 shows.

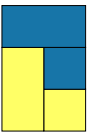

4. As you build the block rotate the block round so that the new piece is always going to be added to the top, join piece number 5 which will make the block square, figure 4.

5. Add piece number 6, figure 5.

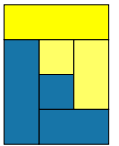

6. Add piece number 7, figure 6.

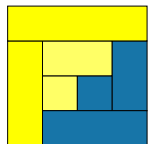

7. Join piece number 8, figure 7.

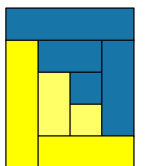

8. Add piece number 9, figure 8.

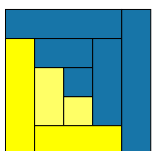

9. Join piece number 10, figure 9.

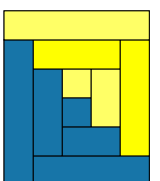
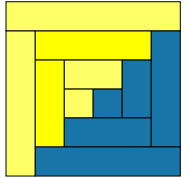

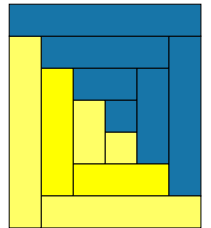
10. Add piece number 11, figure 10.

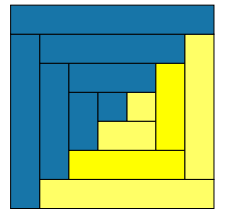
11. Join piece number 12, figure 11.

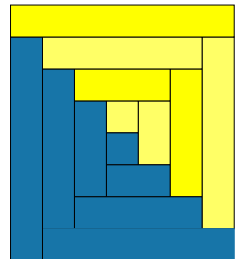
12. Add piece number 13, figure 12.

14. Add piece number 15, figure 14, to complete the block, measure to make sure the block is the correct size, and press the block.

Once you have the block you can make many different quilts such as Barn Rising, Open Windows, Sunburst, Touching Stars and many more.
