This is a block using nine squares it can be pieced by hand or machine. For the best effect use two colours that contrast together.

Fabric 1.  
piece 1.

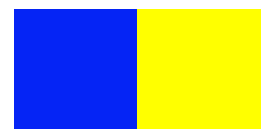
Cut four squares using colour 1 4.5" x 4.5". Piece 1.



Fabric 2  
piece 2

Cut four squares using colour 2 4.5" x 4.5". Piece 2.

Sew a piece 1 and a piece 2 together and press the seam under the darker fabric. Figure 1. Unit 1.



Unit 1.

Sew a piece 1 to the right side of unit 3. Unit 2. Press the seam under the darker fabric. Make 2.



Unit 2.



Sew a piece 2 and piece 1 together press the seam under the darker fabric. Add a piece 2 to the right side of the piece one, again press the fabric under the darker fabric. Figure 2.

Unit 2.



Sew a unit 1 to the top of unit 2, and then sew the second unit 1 to the bottom of the unit 2. Press the seams open. Unit 3.
